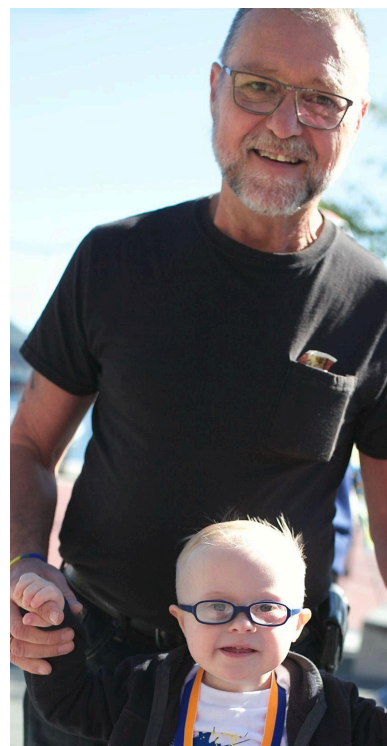

2024 Walk Event planning is underway!

Since its inception in 2013, our Walk has raised more than \$800,000 thanks to more than 10,000 donors, 5,000 participants, hundreds of volunteers and dozens of corporate sponsors.

Down syndrome is the most common genetic disorder affecting 650,000 individuals in the United States. Down syndrome (Trisomy 21) does not have a cure, and the disabilities associated by Down syndrome require a lifetime of specialized care and support. Approximately 2,200 people with Down syndrome live and work in the Baltimore metropolitan area. We estimate 7,500 individuals with Down syndrome live in Maryland.
