Tips to Raise \$500 in One Week

BUDDY WALK FACT SHEET

What:

The Buddy Walk® was created by the National Down Syndrome Society in 1995 to celebrate Down Syndrome Awareness Month in October and to promote acceptance and inclusion of people with Down syndrome. The Buddy Walk has grown from 17 walks in 1995 to more than 250 walks worldwide, raising more than \$13 million was raised nationwide to benefit local programs and services, as well as the national advocacy initiatives of NDSS that benefit all individuals with Down syndrome.

This is the 17th annual walk for the Fun Coast Down Syndrome Association. The Buddy Walk is a one-mile walk in which anyone can participate without special training. After the walk, you and your family will enjoy entertainment for everyone, including face painting, carnival games, music, dancing and more!

Who:

Children, young adults and adults with Down syndrome, family members, friends, healthcare professionals, corporate teams and members of the community – bring a wagon, a stroller and a friend. All are welcome!
