


Step Up for Down Syndrome Walk

The Down Syndrome Information Alliance is hosting its 2023 Step Up for Down Syndrome Walk—its first in-person walk since 2019—on October 8, 2023. **This is your big chance to give back!** DSIA needs your help raising funds to continue our programs and outreach into 2023 and beyond.

FACT SHEET

WHAT: Join the Down Syndrome Information Alliance (DSIA) for our annual 1-mile walk to support Northern California families who have a loved one with Down syndrome and to celebrate Down Syndrome Awareness month. Activities include a children's fun zone and free family-friendly entertainment. The event also includes a resource fair.

WHEN: Sunday, October 8, 2023

WHERE: William Land Park, 3800 S. Land Park, Sacramento, CA

WHO: Approximately 1,000 people are expected to participate in 2023. Participants include people with Down syndrome from the area and surrounding communities, their families, friends, teachers, coworkers, and other supporters. The general public is encouraged to attend and show their support for people of all abilities.

WHY: Step Up for Down Syndrome is our annual community event designed to raise funds for programs supporting people with Down syndrome in the Sacramento and surrounding areas.

Monies raised are used to:

- o Provide new or expectant parents with a comprehensive guide to Down syndrome and one-on-one peer support
- o Fund sponsorships for educational workshops and appointments
- o Educate the medical community on how to compassionately present a diagnosis of Down Syndrome and how to refer families to DSIA for support
- o Provide medical professionals with up-to-date information about Down syndrome
- o Create opportunities for social connection among families



abilities and accomplishments of people with Down syndrome. Step Up for Down Syndrome, formerly Buddy Walk, touches thousands of lives throughout the Sacramento area.


