Who is North Carolina Down Syndrome Alliance?

NCDSA is a non-profit organization committed to being an effective and comprehensive resource on Down syndrome in the Triangle region and throughout North Carolina. We envision a community where all people with Down syndrome can achieve their full potential and where individuals with Down syndrome and their families are welcomed with fairness, enthusiasm and encouragement in their community. Our mission is to empower, connect and support parents of children with Down syndrome and their families and the community. NCDSA will use the funds raised from the Buddy Walk to expand our New & Expectant Parent support, our medical outreach, training & learning academy to the families in North Carolina.

What is the Buddy Walk®?

The Buddy Walk® was started in 1995 by the National Down Syndrome Society to promote awareness and inclusion for people with Down syndrome, as well as to raise money to support education, research, and advocacy initiatives.

What is the High School Challenge?

We are asking each school's National Honors Society, Key Club, Beta Club, friendship circle or Interact Club to get their whole school involved by forming a Buddy Walk® team and raising funds for NCDSA. This is a great way to support a local organization and build your community service hours.
